The abstract should contain less than 300 words and be within 1 page of A4 (standard size of 210 mm × 297 mm). The abstract should state background, objectives, methods and procedures, the main outcomes, results, and concluding remarks. Suggestions or comments for further research or application/practice may be included.


**Keywords:** 3 – 5 keywords separated by semicolons should be provided here to assist with indexing of the article.

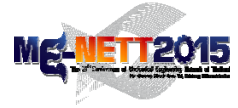
